

#### Greetins to everyone!

As the spring is gone and the board year is closing in on its halfway point, the board is preparing for a generation of students to arrive. Dropping activity levels of freshmen was a concern for many guilds in Herwood during semester 2023/2024 meanwhile TEK has been reporting rising levels of concern towards coping with studies and work amongst the students. These problems have caused conversation on what is causing these concerning phenomena. Could it be the aftereffects of isolation during the lockdown due to Covid-19 at a crucial point of one's social development or higher expectations towards grades and performance during studies? The answers are not clear, but these topics have made well-being and being a technology student in Hervanta as a part of the community some of the top priorities in upbringing of the next generation of Teekkaris.

Summer of 2024 also marks the first complete year of renting Laulumaja which means that it is time to evaluate the performance of the premises and prepare for the next year. More of this subject in the Autumn. Also, the committees are off to a good start. ### News from the IEM unit

There are many positive factors related to our new premises. First, while the space allocated for our unit is a bit smaller as measured in square meters, the layout brings us working in the unit a bit closer together. We jointly remembered past years in Festia and raised a toast to many successful years to come in Tietotalo. Jari Paranko highlighted in his speech the importance of community spirit for the well-being of and success of our unit and pointed out how much damage the covid years have influenced to the community spirit. I fully agree with Jari and look forward to rebuilding many of the things that have been lost in collaboration with all IEM people. This process will however take some time and require effort from us all.

In our forthcoming unit meeting next month we will celebrate the most highly rated courses and discuss the "secrets" behind the highest feedback scores. 
