Hello everyone!

A new year brings new opportunities! I hope your year has started well and that you had a chance to relax during the holidays. At Indecs, the year has kicked off at full speed with the transition of the board and a variety of exciting events.

As you read this, the Indecs board is likely recovering from Tutapäivät. This year, we had the honor of hosting the event for the first time in a long time! What made it even more special was that, for the first time in Tutapäivät history, we welcomed guests from six different cities, as Lahti and Turku have been added to the list of invited guests.

This year, we have put a strong emphasis on strengthening and expanding our external relations. To support these efforts, we introduced a brand-new board position: Foreign Affairs Officer. The role is to develop connections outside Tampere while staying within the borders of Finland. Our goal is to increase collaboration with other guilds and to encourage both the Indecs board and members to experience student life beyond Hervanta.

In addition, this year, the board has decided to apply for Fuksi Officers at the same time as tutors. This way, all tutors can fully focus on Fuksi activities, and the Fuksi Officers won't have any tutoring responsibilities during the year. However, they will only start their role after Wappu, so the timing of the search doesn't affect anything else.

During the Autumn General Assembly 2024, it was also decided to end the rental agreement for Laulumaja after two financially challenging years. Although the agreement is ending, our cooperation with Laulajat has continued and negotiations about possible future arrangements have been actively ongoing. These discussions have now reached a point where it is time to present the results to our members before the Spring GA.

Greetings from the IEM unit

Greetings from the IEM Unit, Dear Students and Alumni,

The year 2024 ended wonderfully. On December 1st, D.Sc. Aki Jääskeläinen was promoted to full professor. Having a new full professor join our "ranks" is not something that happens every year in our unit. We celebrated the year together with a communal lunch at Tampella just before the holiday break. It was a warm, cozy event, and I was glad to see so many employees, including several course assistants, gathered around the two long tables.

I hope that 2025 has started well for you. The beginning of the year has been very positive for the IEM unit due to various factors. Firstly, as you might have recently read in Aamulehti, Tampere University has received over a million euros in funding to develop teaching and research in the area of industrial sales. Much of this activity will take place in the IEM unit, where we are currently recruiting a new industry professor in this domain. This recruitment is expected to be followed by a new tenure track position next year. Although the unit's budget for 2025 has not yet been finalized at the time of writing, the outlook for the current year is positive – even more so than last year. This favorable situation will, for example, allow us to open positions for much-needed postdoctoral researchers, providing opportunities for younger doctors in the IEM field.

This winter, we have decided to personally interview all first-year students. Jouni Lyly-Yrjänäinen will meet each student individually to discuss any topics they wish to raise. I am confident that we will gather valuable information for developing our teaching. Additionally, we aim to be more aware of the issues most important to our students. This is crucial, as we teachers often wonder what student life is like nowadays and how our teaching should adapt to changes in e.g. learning practices, emerging technology (like AI tools) and other factors. I started my own studies at Helsinki University of Technology in 1997, which feels like a very, very long time ago and the world is so different now than it was back then. We read our emails on unix terminals using text-based interface which were state of the art then.

This winter we are also launching a new course for IEM bachelor students called "Kestävä strateginen ajattelu tuotantotaloudessa." The unit is excited to see how the new course concept, which emphasizes interactive discussions and student agency, is received by the students. The course also responds to many students' calls to strengthen our course portfolio regarding sustainability issues.

In a few weeks, the entire IEM unit and I are looking forward to visiting the student guild room to hear about Indecs activities. Thank you very much for the invitation, and we look forward to meeting you soon!



on 1.5., exact location and time will be announced later in the Telegram group. The Alumni Sparkling wine hour is organized by the Alumni Board.




